

POLONIA IN MANITOBA 101 – JEOPARDY 2017 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. **Q:** In his book entitled “Providence Watching. Journeys from Wartorn Poland to the Canadian Prairies” (“Przez boje, przez znoje, przez trud- kombatanckie losy”) he documented a history of the experiences of forty-five individuals, combatants and their families who immigrated to Canada and settled down in Winnipeg.
A: Who is dr Kazimierz Patalas?
2. **Q:** She is currently serving her second term as a president of Polish Canadian Congress.
A: Who is Grazyna Galezowska?
3. **Q:** In 1967, he founded the Polish Dance Ensemble SPK “Iskry” under the auspices of the Polish Combatant Association # 13.
A: Who was Henryk Lorenc?
4. **Q:** He is a long-term president of the Polish Gymnastic Association Sokol Winnipeg.
A: Who is Marian Jaworski?
5. **Q:** He is the former pastor of the Holy Ghost Church who was recently appointed provincial of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate.
A: Who is Alfred Grzempa?
6. **Q:** He is the first Honorary Consul of the Republic of Poland in Winnipeg.
A: Who is dr Wlodzimierz Czarnecki?
7. **Q:** She is the long-standing principal of the Saturday School of Polish Language in Winnipeg.
A: Who is Barbara Torka?
8. **Q:** She serves as Artistic Director & Choreographer of the Polish Dance Ensemble S.P.K. Iskry.
A: Who is Krysia Kovach?
9. **Q:** A bronze relief sculpture, part of the special project to commemorate the 1984 visit of Pope John Paul II and the Mass held at Birds Hill Park, illustrating the Pope as a “World Pilgrim”, was designed and produced by this local artist.
A: Who is Ewa Tarsia ?
10. **Q:** In 1974, he founded CKJS 810 AM a multilingual radio station in Manitoba which is currently serving more than twenty different ethnic group.
A: Who is Casmir Stanczykowski ?

11. **Q:** Born in Winnipeg, the son of Polish immigrants was awarded the Victoria Cross for valour of the highest order in WW II, with a memorial plaque mounted in Kildonan Park and a memorial statue erected in Vimy Ridge Memorial Park.

A: Who is Andrew Mynarski VC ?

12. **Q:** This organization was established in 1963 in Winnipeg by women of Polish background, with goals of preserving Polish culture and language and providing moral and financial aid to women and children in need.

A: What is the Canadian Polish Women's Federation Branch #7?

13. **Q:** He researched and documented in his book "Poles in Manitoba" the early arrivals and settlements of Polish immigrants to Manitoba.

A: Who is Dr. Victor Turek?

14. **Q:** While a president of the Canadian Polish Congress, Manitoba District she established the Polish Studies endowment Fund at the University of Manitoba in 1999, in order to ensure the opportunity to study the Polish language, culture and history at the university level.

A: Who is Zofia de Witt?

15. **Q:** These three Polish organizations have existed continuously for 100 years or more in Winnipeg.

A: what are: 1. Holy Ghost Fraternal Aid Society, 2. Polish Gymnastic Association "Sokol" Winnipeg, 3. Polish Fraternal Aid Society of St. John Cantius?

16. **Q:** To recognize the 200 years of Polish immigrants to Manitoba as part of Lord Selkirk's contingent in 1817, a commemorative plaque was commissioned by the Canadian Polish Congress, Manitoba District to be placed permanently in this location.

A: What is the Manitoba Legislative Building?

17. **Q:** This project is a photographic/pictorial documentation of early Polish churches in Manitoba and other parts of Canada, has been a labor of love of those two very dedicated and committed individuals Grazyna and Lech Galezowski.

A: What is "In the Footsteps of Pioneers"?

18. **Q:** He is the music director and conductor of the Royal Winnipeg Ballet.

A: Who is Tadeusz Biernacki?

19. **Q:** This Church in Winnipeg has relics of Saint Faustina and is a shrine of Divine Mercy.

A: What is St. Andrew Bobola Church?

20. **Q:** This couple has been instrumental in creating and delivering “Radio Polonia” – Polish radio show every Sunday afternoon on CKJS AM 810.

A: Who is Irek i Sabina Lemans?

21. **Q:** This museum’s name means “links” in Polish. Its role is collection, preservation and promotion of the Polish artifacts and Polish experience in Manitoba and Canada.

A: What is Polish Museum Society “Ogniwo”?

22. **Q:** The Canadian-Polish Congress (Polish: Kongres Polonii Kanadyjskiej, KPK), is an organization founded in 1944 by Polish-Canadians in Canada to coordinate the activities and to articulate the concerns of the Canadian Polish community on public policy issues. These seven organizations in Winnipeg are currently under umbrella of KPK Manitoba.
