POLISH HERITAGE MONTH IN MANITOBA

HISTORY HAS BEEN WRITTEN BEFORE OUR EYES!

On May 15, 2023, during the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba, the Minister of Sport, Culture and Heritage, Obby Khan, officially proclaimed the month of May to be Polish Heritage Month within the province of Manitoba. This was the result of cooperation between the NCP board in Manitoba and Minister Obby Khan.

Khan unofficially handed a copy of this statement to the President of KPK - Canadian Polish Congress Manitoba Jolanta Gronowska on May 13 during the celebration of the 75th anniversary of the Polish Combatants Association No. 13 and the 55th SPK Iskra team. The proclamation was officially presented by Prime Minister Heather Stefanson to president Gronowski on May 15 just before its solemn reading in the legislature. The act was adopted by members of the legislature and received royal assent from Anita Neville (Manitoba Lieutenant-Governor), representing the British King Charles III.

Polish Heritage Month will now be celebrated every year throughout May in the province of Manitoba. By declaring May as Polish Heritage Month, the Province has officially recognized the contribution of many generations of Polish Canadians to the history, culture and society of Manitoba. The month of May will be an opportunity to familiarize the people of Manitoba with Polish history and traditions.

In Canada, over a million citizens are of Polish decent, and according to the 2016 census, about 80,000 Polish people live in Manitoba, which they began to settle in 1817, enriching its culture, heritage and becoming an integral part of its multicultural community.



Minister Obby Khan invited Polish children to his office and told them about the work of the Minister of Sport, Culture and Heritage in the government of Manitoba.

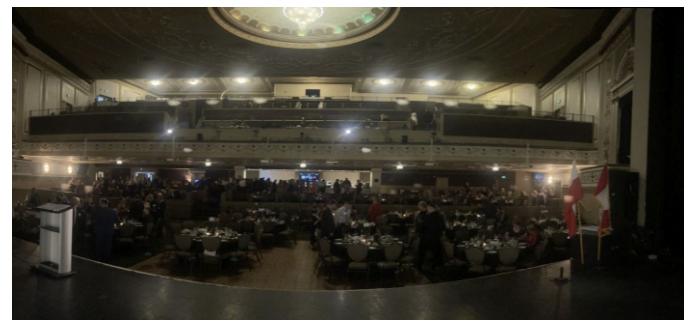

THE GREAT POLISH ASTRONOMER HAS HIS PLACE IN MANITOBA

The Polish community in central Canada honored the memory of the great Polish astronomer. The lakeside resort in Whiteshell Provincial Park has been named after Nicolaus Copernicus since Saturday.

Thanks to the Association of Polish Veterans from Circle No. 13 in Canada, which has its headquarters in Winnipeg. Koło owns a resort on Lake Big Whiteshell in the south-eastern part of Manitoba and decided to celebrate the 550th anniversary of the birth of the Polish astronomer who changed the perception of the cosmos.



Despite the fact that the camp is located at a considerable distance from the city of the winnipeg, many Poles appeared at the ceremonial opening, who took part in the ceremonial naming of the camp after Nicolaus Copernicus. The symbolic moment of naming the center managed by SPK on the Big Whiteshell Lake was the cutting of the white and red ribbon by Paweł Pecold, President of SPK 13, and Jolanta Gronowska, President of KPK Manitoba. The prayer was said and the center under the new name was solemnly consecrated by canon priest Walery Bykowski, pastor of the parish of Saint Andrew Bobola in Winnipeg. Participants of this unique ceremony had the opportunity to see the exhibition, which was designed and funded by the Polish-Canadian Association of Businessmen and Professionals in Windsor, and whose originator is the president of the association, Jerzy Barycki. Both the exhibition and the ceremonial naming of the center on Big Whiteshell Lake after Nicolaus Copernicus are a homage by the Canadian Polish community to the Polish astronomer on the occasion of the 550th anniversary of his birth in 2023.

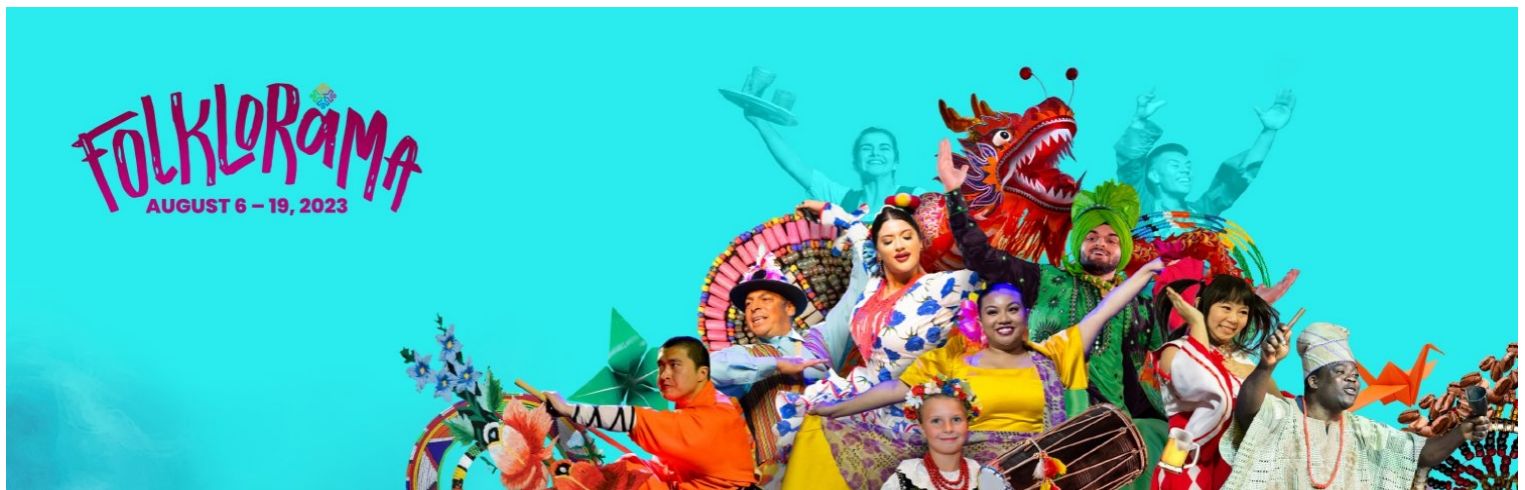
